

Privacy Policy

Belgian Connection has established this privacy policy to explain to you how your information is protected, collected and used, which may be updated by Business in Romania from time to time. Belgian Connection will provide notice of materially significant changes to this privacy policy by posting notice on the Belgian Connection site.

1. Protecting your privacy

- We don't send you unsolicited communications for marketing purposes.
- Belgian Connection does not knowingly collect any information from persons under the age of 13. If Belgian Connection learns that a posting is by a person under the age of 13, Belgian Connection will remove that post.
- Belgian Connection, or people who post on Belgian Connection, may provide links to third party websites, which may have different privacy practices. We are not responsible for, nor have any control over, the privacy policies of those third party websites, and encourage all users to read the privacy policies of each and every website visited.

2. Data we collect

- We sometimes collect your email address, for purposes such as sending selfpublishing and confirmation emails, authenticating user accounts, providing subscription email services, registering for forums, etc.
- We sometimes collect your phone number for account authentication purposes, and may transmit it to a third party service for tele-robotic verification.
- Belgian Connection does not store credit card information. Credit card transactions are transmitted to a financial gateway, and we endeavor to protect the security of your payment information during transmission by using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology.
- We may collect personal information if you provide it in feedback or comments, post it on our pages, or if you contact us directly. Please do not post any personal information on Belgian Connection pages that you expect to keep private.
- Our web logs collect standard web log entries for each page served, including your IP address, page URL, and timestamp. Web logs help us to diagnose problems with our server, to administer the Belgian Connection site, and to otherwise provide our service to you.

3. Data we store

- All postings are stored in our database, even after "deletion," and may be archived elsewhere.
- Our web logs and other records are stored indefinitely.
- Although we make good faith efforts to store the information in a secure operating environment that is not available to the public, we cannot guarantee complete security.

4. Archiving and display of Belgian Connection postings by search engines and other sites

Search engines and other sites not affiliated with Belgian Connection - including archive.org, google.com, and groups.yahoo.com - archive or otherwise make available Belgian Connection postings

5. Circumstances in which Belgian Connection may release information

- Belgian Connection may disclose information about its users if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to respond to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process.
- Belgian Connection may also disclose information about its users to law enforcement officers or others, in the good faith belief that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to: enforce our terms of use; respond to claims that any posting or other content violates the rights of third-parties; or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Belgian Connection, its users or the general public.

6. International Users

By visiting our web site and providing us with data, you acknowledge and agree that due to the international dimension of Belgian Connection we may use the data collected in the course of our relationship for the purposes identified in this policy or in our other communications with you, including the transmission of information outside your resident jurisdiction. In addition, please understand that such data may be stored on servers located in the United States. By providing us with your data, you consent to the transfer of such data.
